Psalm 78:12-20

Psalm 78 gives us a glimpse of a time in Israel's history when they had allowed doubt, discouragement, and disappointment in God to permeate their hearts. This is revealed in that 3 times in verses 19 and 20 they challenge God by asking 1) can God furnish a table in the wilderness? 2) can He give bread also? And 3) can He provide flesh for his people?

While there may always be moments of doubt, discouragement, and disappointment in our life, God never desires for these things to drive our relationship with Him. Rather, He tells us ... the just shall live by faith ... but without faith it is impossible to please Him.
