God's Plan of Faith Promise Giving

As we approach our Faith Promise missions conference, beginning Wednesday night, May 22, it is important for us to understand that God's plan to evangelize the world with the Gospel of Jesus Christ is not through a charity or some parachurch organization but rather it is through the local church.

And God has given the church this plan called Faith Promise (also known as Grace Giving) which affords every believer and every church the opportunity to be involved and obedient to His great commission.

This morning, let's consider three areas of God's Plan of Faith Promise Giving.

In God's plan for missions, He is the ultimate supplier. The church is the sower, and the missionary is the receiver who then ministers the Gospel of Jesus Christ to the lost in their mission field.
