## Shed for Many

The blood of Jesus is ...

**I: Magnificent in its \_\_\_\_\_**: 1 Peter 1:18-18

Now to understand the virtue of the blood atonement of Jesus Christ we must compare the bloodline of mankind to the blood of Jesus Christ. The Bible summarizes that comparison with two simple words ...

A. the \_\_\_\_\_ bloodline of man: Romans 5:12  
Spiritually speaking, the bloodline of mankind is a corruptible bloodline. It has been tainted and corrupted by sin.

B. the \_\_\_\_\_ bloodline of Jesus: Heb. 9:11-12  
The blood of the Lord Jesus Christ is both literally and spiritual incorruptible.

We are not redeemed by the corruptible things of this world such as religion, morality, or good works but rather we are redeemed by the incorruptible blood of Jesus Christ, who is the Lamb without spot or blemish. Jesus Christ was proclaimed to be "the Lamb of God which taketh away the sin of the world" (John 1:29); He shed His incorruptible blood on the cross of Calvary and rose up again on the third day in order that those who put their faith in Him would be redeemed and have their sins forgiven.

Do you understand this morning the virtue of Jesus' blood? It is not tainted but rather divine. It is not corruptible but rather incorruptible.

## Shed for Many

The blood of Jesus is ...

**I: Magnificent in its \_\_\_\_\_**: Col. 1:13-14

How valuable is the blood atonement of Jesus Christ? It is so valuable that there is no other way whereby our sins might be forgiven. Your sin isn't forgiven because you are a Baptist; or because you were baptized in water; or because you are a good person. The Scriptures declare that the only way we can be saved is by way of the shed blood of Jesus Christ.

What does the Bible say about the blood of Jesus? We find three highly valuable attributes of Jesus' blood. We are...

A. \_\_\_\_\_ through His blood (Col. 1:14)

B. \_\_\_\_\_ by His blood (Romans 5:8-9)

C. \_\_\_\_\_ to God by His blood (Heb. 10:19-21)

What magnificent value the blood of Jesus holds for us. Think about it ... His blood redeems you, justifies you, and gives you access to God. There is no way to rightly put a price on the virtue and value of the blood of Jesus Christ.

Do you understand this morning that there is nothing we can offer to God for salvation or appeasement even comes close to the blood of Jesus Christ. But when we put our faith in Jesus, we are then "under the blood" and forgiveness of sin, along with a host of many other things become ours.
